



YARRAMUNDI REACH AND ACACIA INLET

Introduction

1. Yarramundi Reach and Acacia Inlet are located on the parkland at the northwestern end of Lake Burley Griffin.

Booking a Venue

2. Bookings for either the Reach or the Inlet may be made through the National Capital Authority's Events Officer on (02) 6272 2919.

Access

3. The gates to both Yarramundi Reach and Acacia Inlet are only open on weekends and public holidays between 7.00 am and 8.00 pm. Access to the areas at other times is on request to the National Capital Authority. There is no charge for the use of the access keys, however, a bond of \$25 is levied on keys issued by the Authority and the bond is refunded when keys are returned to the Authority by the agreed time.

Car Parks

4. There are no formal parking facilities at either Yarramundi Reach or Acacia Inlet.

Power

5. There are no power outlets at either Yarramundi Reach or Acacia Inlet.

Water

6. There is no public access to fresh water at either Yarramundi Reach or Acacia Inlet.

Public Toilets

7. The public toilets at both Yarramundi Reach and Acacia Inlet are currently closed and unserviceable.

Barbecues

8. There are no barbecue facilities located at either Yarramundi Reach or Acacia Inlet.

Structures

9. Structures (works) may be erected in both Yarramundi Reach or Acacia Inlet, however, any proposed structures are to be submitted to the National Capital Authority on a Works Approval for an Event application form, accompanied by a detailed map showing the exact location of the proposed works. Structures (works) include marquees, tents, sun-shelters, fencing, barricades, amusements (eg. jumping castles), stages, dais's, signs, banners, port-a-loos, buoys etc. A works request normally incurs a Works Application Fee.

10. Applications for a works approval may be obtained from the National Capital Authority's Events Officer on (02) 6272 2919.

Camping

10. Camping at the Reach or the Inlet, day or night, is not permitted.
